OutLook Study Backgrounder

What is the OutLook Study?

The OutLook Study is a very significant research project for Waterloo Region – it is designed to learn more about Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ) people who live, work, or go to school in Waterloo Region. It is also designed to learn more about the sexual health needs of men who have sex with men (MSM) in Waterloo Region.

OutLook is different from most large research studies in that community partners worked in collaboration with public health and university based researchers to build and implement all project phases. From May to November of 2016, the OutLook Study Team collected responses from 526 LGBTQ participants in an online survey. The survey questions were derived from existing surveys on LGBTQ communities (e.g. HiMMM, Trans PULSE), as well as from members of the OutLook Study Team. It was important to the team to have the survey items be inclusive of issues facing LGBTQ communities. We wanted to ensure that the questions being asked could better illuminate the voice of those with lived experience as LGBTQ individuals.

What is the purpose of the OutLook Study?

Once the information has been collected, analyzed and distributed (eg. through community meetings, factsheets, reports, etc.), members of the OutLook Study Team, the Rainbow Community Council (RCC), and other community partners will work to develop initiatives that promote the health and well-being of Waterloo Region's LGBTQ and MSM communities.

Who is the OutLook Study Team?

The OutLook Study Team is a sub-committee of the Rainbow Community Council (RCC). It is a working group comprised of representatives from Region of Waterloo Public Health & Emergency Services (WRPHES), the AIDS Committee of Cambridge, Kitchener, Waterloo & Area (ACCKWA), the Waterloo Region Rainbow Coalition, Wilfrid Laurier University (WLU), and various other organizations and members of the community.
